

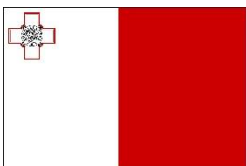
STQARRIJA MILL-MINISTERU GĦALL-AGRIKOLTURA, SAJD, IKEL U DRITTIJET TAL-ANIMALI – SKEMA TA’ KUMPENS GĦAL-WAQFIEN TEMPORANJU TAS-SAJD.

Permezz tal-Fond Ewropew Għall-Affarijiet Marittimi u S-Sajd 2014-2020, id-Dipartiment tas-Sajd u Akkwakultura fi ħdan il-Ministeru tal-Agricoltura, Sajd, L-ikel u Drittijiet tal-Animali qed iħabbar li se jniedi skema ta’ kumpens għas-sajjieda li jistadu attivament għall-pixxispad u qed jiddikjaraw li ser jieqfu temporanjament mill-attivitajiet tas-sajd għax-xahar ta’ Diċembru 2021. Dan għaliex il-Gvern ħass li għandu jestendi il-perjodu tas-sajd magħluq b’xahar, matul ix-xahar ta’ Diċembru 2021 bil-għan li nieħdu ħsieb l-*istocks* ta’ ħut, b’mod speċjali, il-pixxispad li jikber/jimraħ fl-ibħra tagħna.

Din l-iskema tipprovdi kumpens lil dawk is-sajjieda li huma rreġistrati mad-Dipartiment tas-Sajd u Akkwakultura bħala MFA u MFB. Barra minn hekk, l-iskema ta’ kumpens hija applikabbli biss għal-dawk is-sajjieda li għabru l-awtorizzazzjoni valida biex jistadu għall-pixxispad fl-2021, għandhom il-valur minimu ta’ qbid ta’ ħut matul l-2019 u l-2020 skont il-Legislazzjoni Sussidjarja 425.07 skeda III, għandhom il-valur minimu ta’ qbid ta’ pixxispad matul 2019 u l-2020 kif stipulat fl-applikazzjoni u rreġistraw 120 jum fuq il-baħar mit-**30 ta’ Settembru 2019 sa 1 t’Ottubru 2021**.

Fil-granet li ġejjin ħa jibdew jitqassmu l-applikazzjonijiet lis-sajjieda konċernati. Dawk interessati għandhom jibgħatu bil-posta l-applikazzjoni tagħhom flimkien ma dokumentazzjoni oħra mitluba lid-Dipartiment tas-Sajd u Akkwakultura għewwa l-Għammieri sa mhux aktar tard mill-31 t’Ottubru 2021.

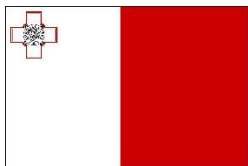
PRESS RELEASE FROM THE MINISTRY FOR AGRICULTURE, FISHERIES, FOOD AND ANIMAL RIGHTS- TEMPORARY CESSATION OF FISHING ACTIVITIES SCHEME

Through the European Maritime and Fisheries Fund 2014-2020, the Department of Fisheries and Aquaculture within the Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries, Food and Animal Rights is announcing that it will launch a compensation scheme for those fishermen who actively fish for swordfish and declare that they will temporarily cease fishing activities for the month of December 2021. This is because the Government felt that it should extend the closed fishing period by one month, during the month of December 2021 with the aim of taking care of fish stocks, especially swordfish that nest in our local waters.

This scheme provides compensation to those fishermen who are registered with the Department of Fisheries and Aquaculture as MFA and MFB. In addition, the compensation scheme is only applicable to those fishermen who have obtained a valid authorization to fish for swordfish in 2021, have the minimum catch value during 2019 and 2020 in accordance with Subsidiary Legislation 425.07 schedule III, have the minimum value of swordfish catches during 2019 and 2020 as set out in the application and registered 120 days at sea from **30th September 2019 until 1st October 2021**

Applications will be sent to eligible fishermen in the coming days. Those interested should send by mail their application together with other requested documentation to the Department of Fisheries and Aquaculture in Għammieri by the 31st of October 2021.
