Re. Access to the Electronic Veterinary Prescription (e-VetPres)

The Veterinary Medicines Section (VMS) will be holding online explanatory sessions about the Veterinary Electronic Prescriptions (e-VetPres) throughout the Year 2022. The focus of these online session is to explain to you the layout and functions of the e-VetPres.
